Dorey Financial Modelling Regatta 2025 Notice of Race

5 & 6 July 2025

Organising Authority: Guernsey Yacht Club LBG

1. RULES

The event will be governed by the:

- 1.1 Rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing, including the Prescriptions of the RYA*.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority. If this rule is broken World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY FEES

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all classes of dinghy. Races will be held using Portsmouth Yardstick Handicaps as published by the RYA,
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing an Entry Form, that will be available on the Guernsey Yacht Club website from 5 June 2025 and paying the required fee by Tuesday 1 July 2025.
- 3.3 The entry fee will be £10 per boat. Late entries will be accepted up to 10am Saturday 5 July 2025 by paying an additional £10.
- 3.4 There will be a social event, after racing, on Saturday 5 July 2025 at Guernsey Yacht, details of which will be sent to all entrants. Competitors and non-competitors are very welcome.

4. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 4.1 The championship will take place over Saturday 5 and Sunday 6 July 2025 with six open handicap races over the two days. The target running time will be approximately 45 minutes for each race. The number of races each day will not exceed 4.
- 4.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Saturday 5 July will be 13:25. On Sunday 6 July, the scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race will be 10:00 and no warning signal will be made after 13:30.
- 4.3 The warning signal for subsequent races will be made as soon as practicable after the finish of the preceding race.

5. MEASUREMENTS

- 5.1 Each boat shall conform to its 'as built' specifications or produce a valid class certificate except that in the manufacturers' one design classes replica sails may be used with the Sailing Committee's approval. Where a boat has been modified the Organising Authority may allocate a revised handicap for this event only. It shall be the helmsman's responsibility to declare any and all modifications.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1 The Sailing Instructions will be published on the Guernsey Yacht Club website by 3 July 2025.

7. VENUE

- 7.1 The Venue is the Guernsey Yacht Club.

7.2 The Racing Area is the Little Russell.

8. COURSES

8.1 Courses will be Windward/Leeward and Windward/Reach/Reach style as described in the Sailing Instructions.

9. SCORING

The Scoring System is:

9.1 Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

9.2 When five or more races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst result.

10. BOAT PARKING

10.1 Boats will be parked at the Guernsey Yacht Club for the duration of the regatta.

11. RADIO COMMUNICATION

11.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

12. PRIZE GIVING

Prize giving will take place as soon as is possible after sailing on 6 July 2025.

13. DISCLAIMER

13.1 Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

14. INSURANCE

14.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000 (two million pounds) per incident or the equivalent.
